Bicycle Routes

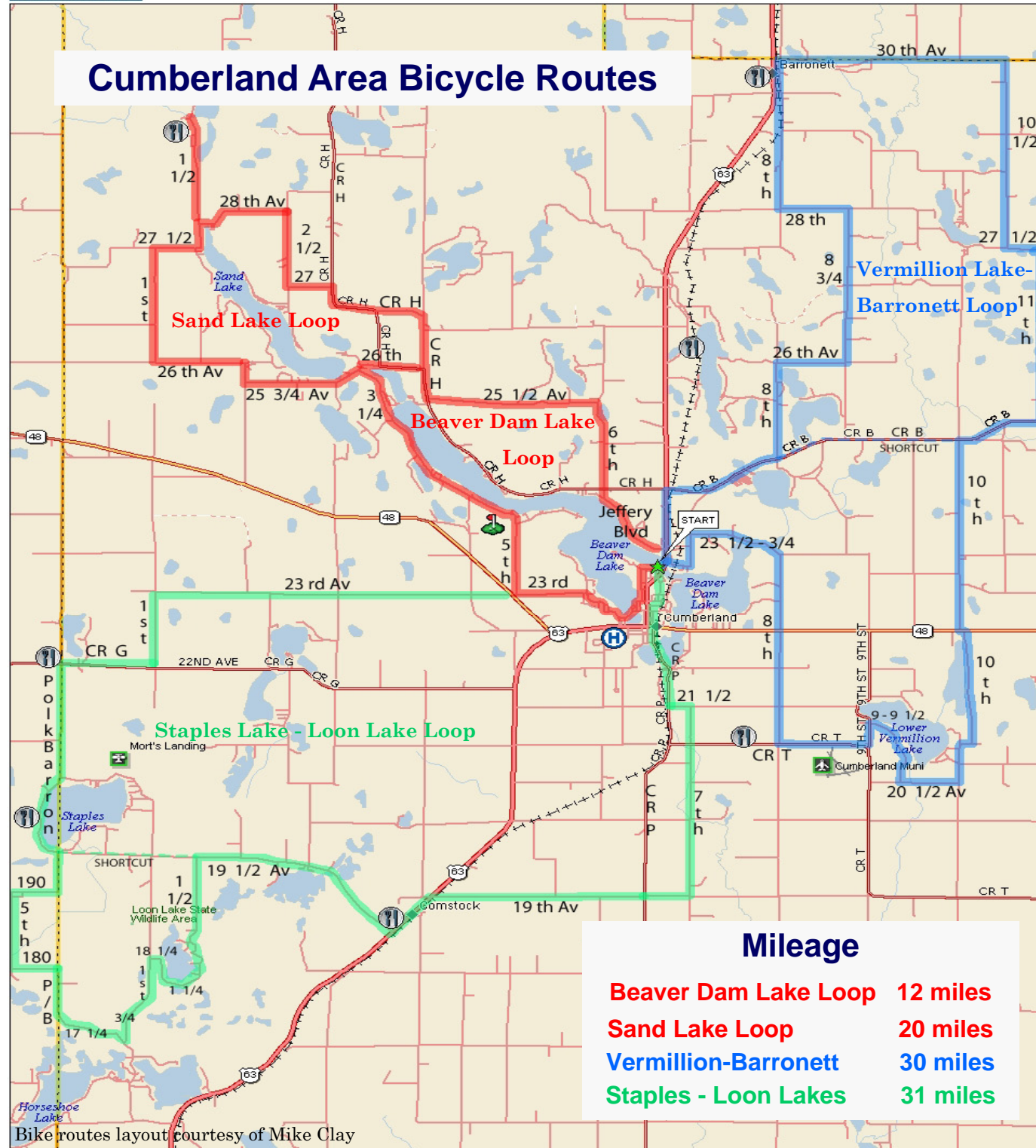


Cumberland, Wisconsin

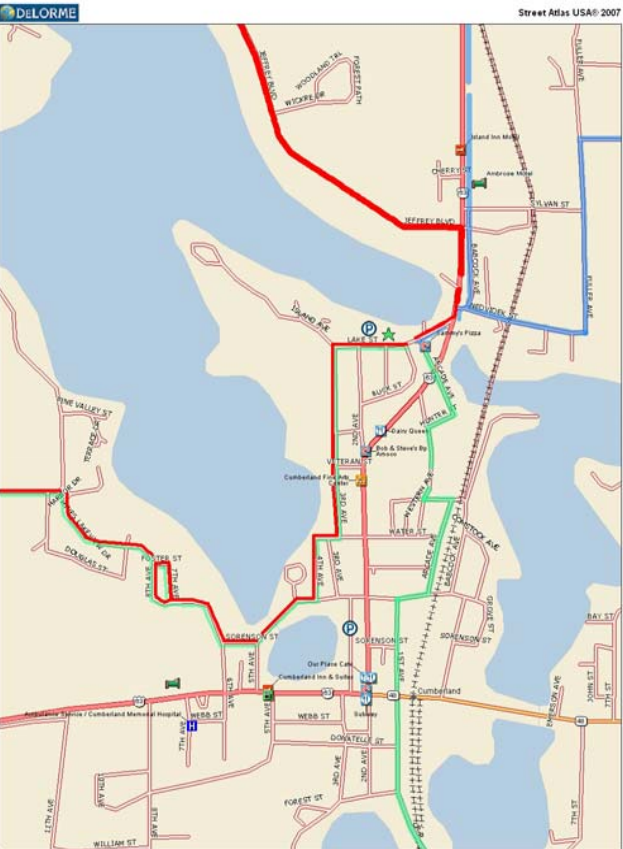


Cumberland Area Bicycle Routes
